Why train to SpeedThink?

Time is more than money... Project work needs more creative problem solving and flexibility in thinking under time pressure than normal routine work. The people must become more service-oriented to the organizations to which they belong. People have as many different mindsets as their individuality and aspirations. What is the training about?
