24. Repeal of the organization :- (1) If the general meeting deems necessity then in the presence of 75% of total number of members, passing special resolution the organization could be repealed.
- (2) While passing the resolution of repeal in accordance with sub-section (1) it could be done only after clearing all the liabilities by the general meeting.
- (3) In case of not done functions in accordance with the constitution of the organization or in the condition of resolution or repeal of the organization by any other reason then all moveable and immoveable properties, cash and goods shall go automatically in the ownership of His Majesty's Government.
25. Shall be in accordance with the Act:- The matters having not stated in this constitutions shall be in accordance with the prevailing laws and if they become in consistency with the Organization Registration Act, Rules and Prevailing Laws then those matters shall be automatically in active.
26. Miscellaneous :-
- (1) If there comes complain before the local authority stating that the Executive Committee is not working remaining under it's functions, duties and rights and against the objectives of the organization, if it is proved while doing investigation, then dissolving the committee and forming Ad hoc committee from among the general members of the organization till the period of not having another committee, and making done the election of the Executive Committee, it could forward the functions and proceedings of the organization.
- (2) The functions as written in this constitution shall be done by the organization remaining within the ambit of policy and directions of His Majesty's Government having not against the intention of prevailing Nepal Laws.
- (3) This organization shall conduct its functions remaining quite separate in any political activities.
- (4) Following of Directions :- To follow the directions provided by the local authority at time to time shall be the duty of the chief of the organization.
